We wish to recreate shots like this in the performance section of our video as low angle shots of band members are conventional.



We will also get some close ups of the lead singer. This is another convention of Alternative Rock and will look effective when we use short sharp cuts.



A long shot from the side is key when filming the performance section of our video. It will help show the link between the whole band, showing their edgy and playful nature.



We will get a low angle group shot as this will position the audience below them giving the feel that the band has got the power.



A close-up shallow focus is key for us to get for the guitarist, this will look interesting for the audience and keep their eyes on the screen.



With a long shot like this the focus is put on the drummer as he is the only one in the frame. The plain background also adds to the focus which has been put on the drummer



This shot shows the whole band however the lead singer is in the foreground of the shot.



Fast pans along past the musicians, adds to the pace. Pans up revealing the instruments and the musicians.



Here is a performance shot looking like they are at a concert, we may do a concert style set however we are thinking of going slightly more low key but will get a variety of interesting shots similar to this side angle.



A variety of movement shots around the lead singer is key for our genre of music. It will also add to the effect of the backing track which is fast paced and energetic.
