

Font is very plain, almost boring, floating in sky connoting the flags floating also.

Colour scheme shown is bright, vibrant and clear, basic colours work well together as there is a clear separating contrast between them.

No apparent members of the band in this album cover however the two people could be shown throughout the narrative in the music videos.

Mise-en-scene is rather unclear within the album cover however it looks as if they are wearing their best Sunday outfit, man in suit and lady in dress. - Another key point to show the celebration of the french revolution.

Fire in the bottom left third of the image, could connote the beginning of the french revolution, and all bad things coming to an end as there is just one small fire left around fields containing nothing.

Bold, simple album title and group name, clear to read and well spaced out. Nicely centered in the top middle third of the image.

Sky has rather bright harsh lighting bringing the focus on the couple and flags very clear. Also suggests the cruel and severe times during the revolution.

French Revolution, very patriotic and symbolic, red white and blue like the french flag. Clear contrasting colours of the red flag and blue flag and the white from the sky. France is well known from its revolutionary passed.

Background suggests the freedom of the two members in the album cover. Man and woman standing opposite each other in the open area of the countryside, nothing around but greenland and a white sky giving the idea that they are far away from anyone and everything.

Is it a celebration of freedom or are the couple in trouble? Freedom is suggested by the flags flying high, trouble could be shown through the flag being wrapped around their faces. Connoting they are in danger.
