

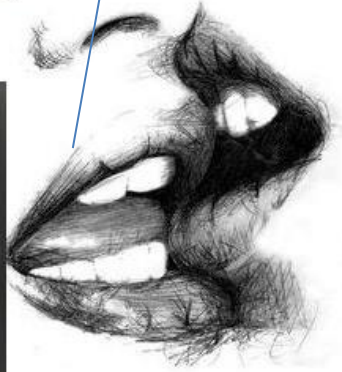

I really like the idea of using skulls as it associated with being edgy which would suit my genre, however I feel the red and pink colour palette is too feminine.

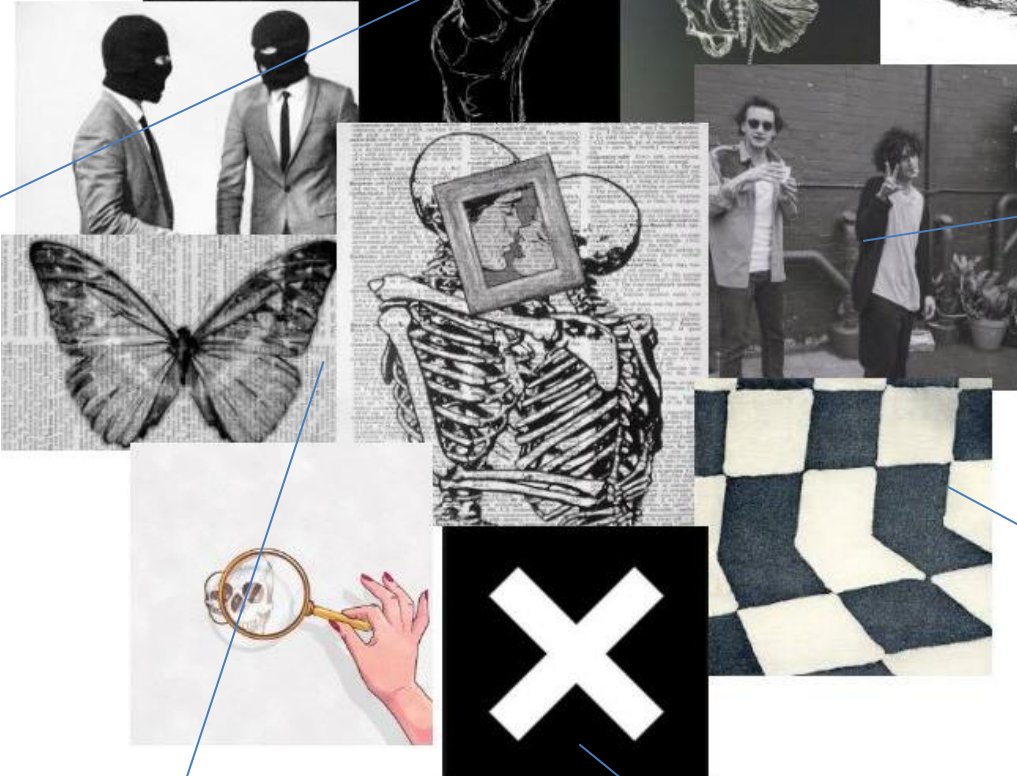
Cool design, bit too colourful.
